2015-2016 OPTIONAL CHAPEL OFFERINGS

Chapel is held the first Wednesday and Thursday of each month from September–May.

Children can donate items that will be part of Peace Lutheran Church’s box ministry. Each month a different agency in the Grand Island community will be featured. See the chart below for suggested items for the each month. Children can also donate canned or packaged food items or paper products for the Grand Island Food Pantry. These donations are taken after each chapel to the food pantry.

And children can bring money that is donated to help support Xiomely, our World Vision child, in the country of Peru. **Children can bring money ANY DAY they have preschool to place in the jar during Jesus time. They do not have to wait until chapel day.** At the end of each semester the money collected is sent to World Vision to help provide food and clean water for people where Xiomely lives. Letters that we receive from her are shared with the children and put in a scrapbook. All classes are given an opportunity to make something to share with Xiomely that will be mailed to her along with a letter telling her about our preschool. Your child can also make something at home to send to her.

January	Red Cross	Bottled water and sports drinks, granola and protein bars, jerky
February	Third City Community Clinic	Toothbrushes and Toothpaste
March	Habitat for Humanity	Paper plates, napkins, hand wipes, utility knives (in package) bottled water
April	Veteran’s Home	Playing cards, candy, snacks, hygiene items
May	VBS on the Road	(Items will be determined)
